2) Student activities in the first project year:

a) Before meeting :

- Select the students and prepare for the work in Bratislava – each student must be prepared for working in international group
- Make research and questionnaire, prepare a video about the situation at school and interviews themselves (about 90 sec)
- Prepare for the SM e.g. PPT or video:
 - a. Introduction school/pupils
 - b. Circumstances at schools +/- aspects
 - c. Situation in the countries +/- aspects
- Investigation: Questionnaire – on Google Drive – for students and teachers (20 people - main target group) and parents, each country has its own version:
 - a. Consumption, waste, recycling
 - b. Pollution and climate change
 - c. The conscious use of resources at school and at home
(travelling to school, rubbish and plastic, electronic waste, electricity use, water use)



- Suggestions – how to improve:
 - a. Consumption, waste, recycling
 - b. Pollution and climate change
 - c. The conscious use of resources at school and at home
 - eTwinning platform for communication- get used to it, change the information

On SM in Bratislava (6 students + 2 teachers per country = 36+12 = 48 participants) - the questionnaire has to be completed and the results of the survey as well as an account of the learning activities in the local areas will be brought to Bratislava to be compared.

In Bratislava - Each group will evaluate the questionnaire and compares the results. They would then make a set of ideas for practical actions to improve the environmental situation in their schools.

3) Activities during 1stInternational Students Conference in Bratislava – March 9 - 13 2020:

- a) Monday – arrival and short sightseeing tour on the Bratislava Castle
- b) Tuesday – after welcome and short team-building
 - a. Introduction of school/students
 - b. Work in 6 international groups
 - c. Evaluation of Questionnaire
 - d. Afternoon learning activity
- c) Wednesday – **work in 6 groups– one student from each country**
 - a. Discussing first the ideas from schools
 - b. Developing ideas
 - c. Afternoon learning activity
- d) Thursday – **work in 6 groups – one student from each country**
 - a. Developing concrete ideas that are particularly relevant for the different schools
 - b. Prepare presentation of results
 - c. Result schedule:
